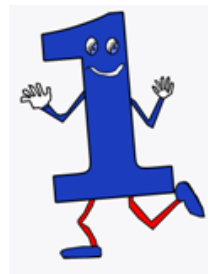
not already a member, sign up that day and get a piggy bank.
